

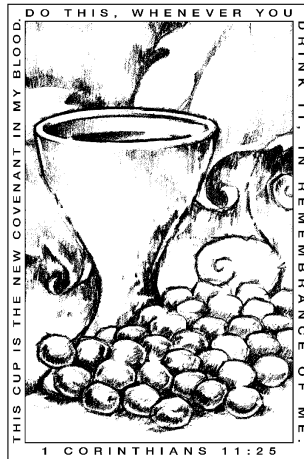

New Study starting February 19th ; First Hour:

"All Roads Lead to Rome" Rome was the epicenter of one of the greatest empires in world history and the apostle Paul's letter to the Romans is often cited as Paul's greatest writing. Chrysostom had it read to him twice a week for many years. Luther, in his famous preface, says "This Epistle is the chief book of the New Testament, the purest Gospel. It deserves not only to be known word for word by every Christian, but to be the subject of his meditation day by day, the daily bread of his soul." Melancthon hand copied it twice to reinforce his personal knowledge of it and it is the book which he expounded on most frequently. The Holy Spirit most definitely used this letter in the spawning of the Reformation, and also in millions of personal reformations for two thousand years. We're going to study this great letter together in the 1st Hour ABC class this Spring starting February 19th through the end of May. We invite you to join us.
