

## *Mary K. Mohler*

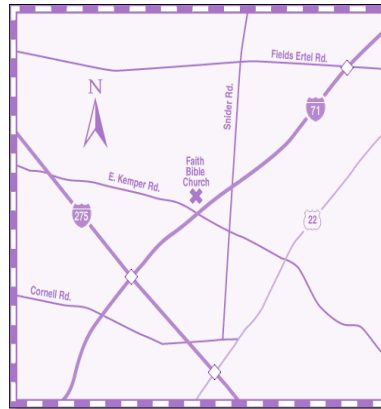
